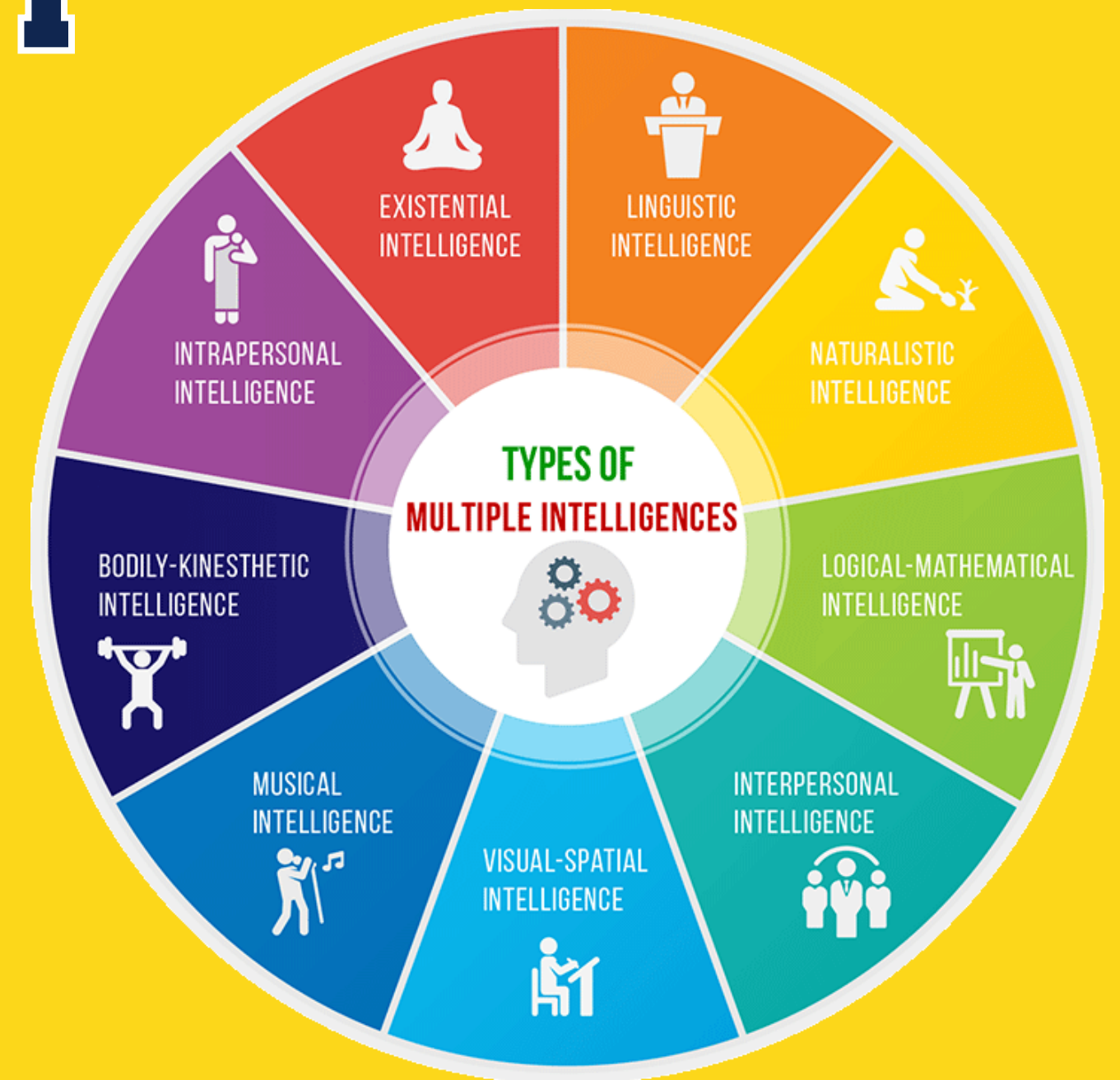
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GENIUS-LEVEL TALENT

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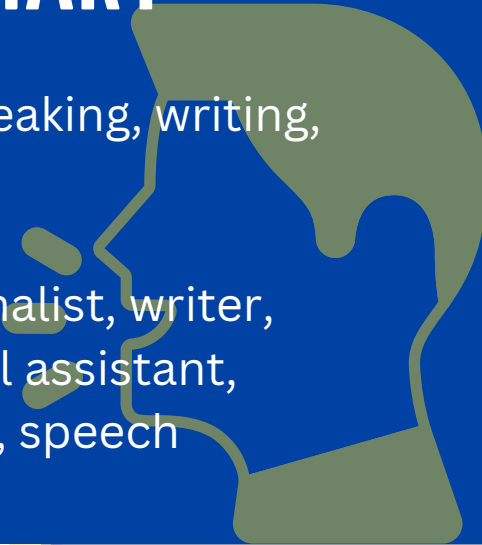
MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCE THEORY BREAKDOWN

1 WORD SMART

Skills – Listening, speaking, writing, teaching.

Careers – Poet, journalist, writer, teacher, lawyer, legal assistant, politician, translator, speech pathologist.



2 PICTURE SMART

Skills – puzzle building, painting, constructing, fixing, designing objects.

Careers – Graphic designer, landscape architect, photographer, mechanic, engineer, inventor, artist.



3 NATURE SMART

Skills – Recognize one's connection to nature, apply science theory to life.

Careers – Horticulturalist, gardener, landscape architect, farmer, park ranger, animal trainer, naturalist, conservationist, scientist



4 REASONING SMART

Skills – Problem-solving (logical & math), performing experiments.

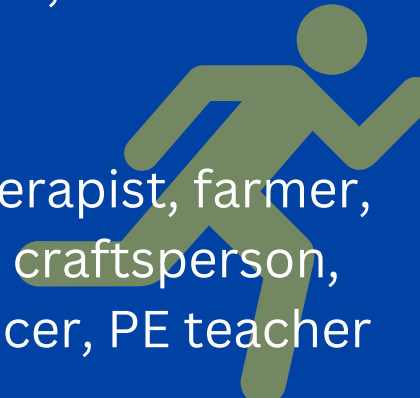
Careers – Purchasing agent, statistician, data mining analyst, scientists, engineers, accountants, mathematicians

Skills – Singing, playing instruments, composing music.

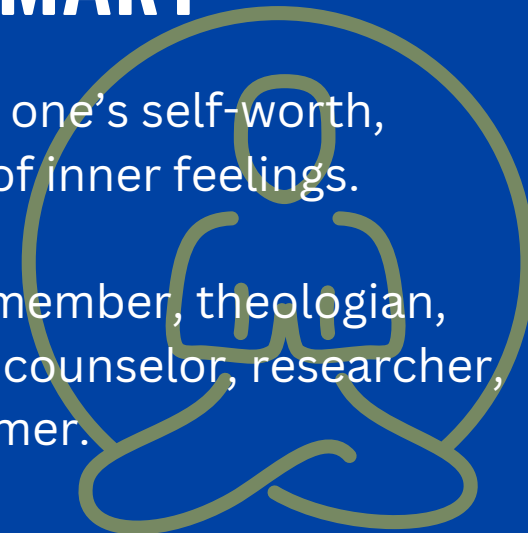
Careers – Musician, disc jockey, singer, composer, music teacher, musical therapist, musical journalist.

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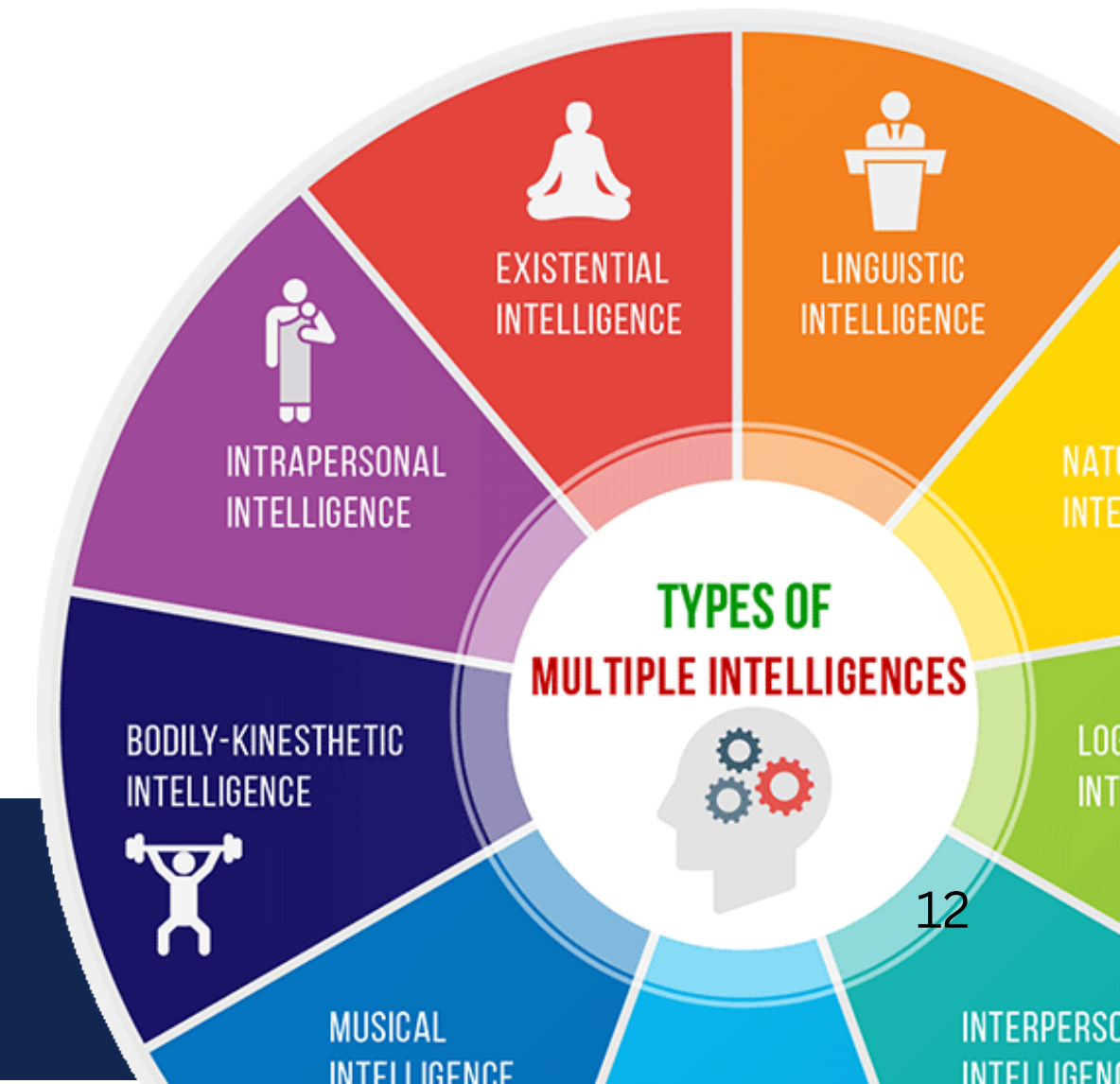
